Directions

The National Water Sports Centre, 5 miles south of Nottingham.

From the south: turn off at junction 24 of the M1; take the A453 towards Nottingham and then the A52 towards Grantham. Follow signs to the National Water Sports Centre. (Coming from the south you can also turn off the M1 at junction 21A, and use the A46.)

From the north: turn off at junction 26 of the M1; take the A610 and then the A52 towards Grantham. Follow signs to the National Water Sports Centre.

From the east: from the A46 near Bingham take the A52 towards Nottingham. Continue straight ahead at the roundabout at which the A52 goes left. The right turn to the National Water Sports Centre is just ahead at the lights.
