### Support you require from regional and national organisations to promote CAF/LP/Integrated Working

Regular information disseminated and good practice shared.  
Follow up with more focussed learning sets/problem solving.  
E-mail list of those involved/able to have information/documents etc.  
Regular updates on successful implementation in other places to prompt discussion and action.  
Support with workforce development issues and links to regional partners.  
Continue to share good practice - what works well as well as sharing difficulties.  
Financial support, IT support, clear focussed, central information.  
Now I see the information sharing bit/role for you. You need to run training on this one.  
Dissemination of best practice.  
Keep up the good work.  
Attend more central events as CAF/LP expands/grows/develops.  
Guidance on the interface between CAF and statutory SEN procedures.  
Promotion of the idea that some people not apparently involved, can have key skills to be Lead Professionals and to be involved in CAF processes (e.g. youth workers)  
Fund follow up meeting 1 year down the line and continue to champion CAF as an effective and dynamic tool  
More support at the front line to improve the lives of children e.g. mental health services and housing and employment  
Give us examples from different regions.  
Access to training re being a Lead Professional.  
Good share good practice - particularly on Lead Professional - examples given/shared.  
Examples of CAF Champions in different sectors.  
Further days like this.  
Workshops like today.  
Feedback from the event to use as Team Development in the workplace.  
Information about pros and cons about different approaches across the region.  
More on evidence and outcomes - what has actually changed for children and families.  
Support strategy to delivery - impact on the child - performance monitoring.  
Regional conferences very beneficial.  
CWDC to get more involved.
